PRIVACY POLICY

Federal Act on Data Protection (DPA) – enacted on 19 June 1992.

Ordinance to the Federal Act on Data Protection (DPO) – enacted on 14 June 1993

THE CONTROLLER OF THE DATA FILE

As a consequence of the visit to this Site, the data referring to identified or identifiable people are subject to be processed. The Controller of the data file is DELTA LINE SA, which is based in Via Industria 16, CH-6814 Lamone (Switzerland).

PLACE OF PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

The treatments related to the web services of this website take place at the service provider appropriately appointed by the Controller of the data file and are only handled by technical staff in charge of occasional maintenance operations

KINDS OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED

- Navigation data -

The computer-based systems and the software procedures involved in the working of this Web site, in the course of their normal service, come into possession of some personal information, the transmission of which is implied in the use of the protocols of Internet communication.

This information is not collected to be associated to any identified people, but, through processes and associations with data owned by third parties, by its own nature might lead to the identification of users.

In this category of data are included the IP addresses or the names stored in the domain of the computers used by those who access the Site, the addresses in notation URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) of the required resources, the time of the request, the method used to forward the request to the server, the size of the file received in reply, the digit code showing the state of the reply given by the server (good, error, etc...) and other parameters connected with the operating system and the structure and conditions of the user's computer.

This data is used only to get anonymous statistical information about the use of the Site and to check its correct performance and is deleted immediately after processing. The data might be used to investigate responsibilities, should there be any data processing offences against the Site: apart from this possibility, at present the data on Web contacts does not last for more than seven days.

- Data voluntary provided by the user -

The optional, explicit and voluntary forwarding of personal data from the user on registration forms present on this site implies the subsequent acquisition of the data provided by the sender, which is essential to the processing of the required service. Specific, concise information to data subjects will progressively be reported or displayed on the pages of the Site set up for particular services on demand.

COOKIES

Cookies are text files placed on your computer's hard drive by a web page server. Your computer is probably configured to accept cookies, but you can modify your parameters to reject them. We recommend you do this if you are concerned about receiving cookies.

The table below explains the cookies we use and why.

In addition to the cookies set out in above table, the presence of so-called session cookies could also be seen; these cookies are not stored permanently on the user's computer and disappear when the browser is closed. Their use is strictly limited to transmitting session identifiers (consisting of random numbers generated by the server) necessary to allow the fruition of a particular service and the safe and efficient exploration of the site. The so-called session cookies used in this site avoid the use of other technologies that could compromise the privacy of user's browsing and do not permit the acquisition of personal identification data.

However, most browsers allow some control of most cookies through the browser settings. If you do not wish to receive any type of cookie on your computer, from this site or from others, the level of privacy protection can be raised through the appropriate [functions on your computer](#).

VOLUNTARY PROVIDING OF PERSONAL DATA

Except for what has been specified for navigation data, the user is free to provide the personal information stated on request forms or indicated during contacts with the Office to further the dispatch of information material or of other communications.

PROCESSING ARRANGEMENTS

Personal data is processed with automated instruments only for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the data was collected or subsequently processed.

Specific security procedures are in place to prevent the risk of their destruction or loss, whether by accident or not, of unauthorized access to the data or of processing operations that are either unlawful or inconsistent with the purposes for which the data has been collected. DELTA LINE SA have adopted all the Minimum Security Measures provided by the law. DELTA LINE SA., in accordance with the main international

standards, and have also taken further security measures to minimize risks relating to the confidentiality, integrity and availability of the personal data collected and processed.

SHARING, COMMUNICATION AND DISSEMINATION OF DATA

The data we collect may be transferred or communicated to others related to DELTA LINE SA for activities closely connected and instrumental to the efficiency of the service, such as the management of the data processing system, or for processing made by the other companies for the same purposes.

Apart from said cases, data will not be disclosed nor given to anybody unless this is in compliance with contractual and legal obligations or users have given their consent. Therefore, personal information may be transmitted to third parties solely and exclusively if:

1. there is a consent to share data with third parties;
2. there is the need to share the information in order to process users' requirements;
3. it is essential to comply with legal duties.

No data whatsoever coming from the Web is ever disclosed or circulated.

DATA SUBJECT'S RIGHTS

Data subjects will be entitled to the rights provided by Swiss (data protection) law, in particular:

- a) the right to information (Art. 8-9 DPA; Art. 1-2 DPO), notably the right to request information from the controller of a data file as to whether data concerning him/her is being processed, respectively the duty of the former to provide all available data concerning the subject in the data file, including the available information on the source of the data, the purpose of and, if applicable, the legal basis for the processing as well as the categories of the personal data processed, the other parties involved with the file and the data recipient;
- b) the right to request the rectification of the incorrect data (Art. 5 para. 2 DPA).

CHANGES TO THE CURRENT PRIVACY POLICY

DELTA LINE SA checks their own privacy and security policy regularly and, if necessary, review it in accordance with the amendments introduced by the law, the organization, or prompted by technological evolution. Any changes to said policy will be posted on this page.
